QUEEN TROPHY 2026 REGULATIONS

In the event of a dispute, only the original regulations in Italian shall be considered valid.

These regulations complement the general FMI regulations.

Participation in the event implies the automatic acceptance of the co-responsibility agreement by all participants. Please read the terms carefully before confirming your registration.

Art. 1 – Organization

The Motoclub Pepe BEVAGNA A.S.D., with its registered office at Via Monte Acuto 7 – 06034 Foligno (PG) and administrative office at Via Salvo D'Acquisto 6 – 06031 Bevagna (PG), President Cesare Pompei, tel. 347369696, motoclubpeppebevagna@gmail.com, organizes the 9th edition of the Queen Trophy Adventouring, an Adventouring Tourism event included in the FMI national calendar, which will take place from September 3 to 6, 2026.

Art. 2 – Nature of the Event

The event is on national scale, non-competitive (as provided by the FMI Adventouring Tourism regulations), with a touch of adventure. Its purpose is historical and cultural: participants will have the opportunity to discover little-known places, towns, and local traditions.

- The route includes approximately 30% paved roads and 70% natural-surface roads, divided into 3 stages for a total of about 660 km.
- All roads are open to traffic; therefore, strict compliance with the Road/Traffic Code is mandatory.
- The organization will provide the routes' instructions via GPX track.
- The routes have been communicated to local authorities; participants must follow the indicated and provided routes.
- The indicated mileage may vary due to unforeseen circumstances or mandatory detours.

Art. 3 – Admitted Motorcycles

- Motorcycles: All-terrain motorcycles that are not specialist enduro bikes, as per FMI regulations, with a weight above 150 kg.
- Motorcycles under 150 kg are allowed only for:
 1. Women, with any type of all-terrain motorcycle, including enduro.
 2. Men over 65 years of age, with any type of all-terrain motorcycle, including enduro.
 3. Motorcycles listed in the historic register, or over 20/30 years old, registered in the FMI historic register.
 4. All motorcycles must comply with the Road/Traffic Code.
Any motorcycle change must be communicated by August 20, 2026; failure to do so will result in exclusion from the event without the right to a refund.
 5. Test plates are prohibited.

Art. 4 – Safety and Clothing

- For greater safety, it is mandatory to wear technical Enduro-specific gear, including an approved helmet and Enduro gloves. The use of additional protective and safety equipment—such as knee guards, elbow guards, high-protection technical boots, airbag vests, neck braces, etc.—is highly recommended. Participants without the required equipment will not be allowed to start the event and will not be entitled to a refund.
- Motorcycles must be equipped with knobby (off-road) tires; participation will not be permitted without them, and no refund will be granted.

Art. 5 – Participant Requirements

- The event is open to citizens of any country who hold a valid motorcycle driving license recognized for use in Italy, and who possess an FMI Member card (Italian Motorcycling Federation), which sponsors the event and

provides insurance coverage for the participant. The FMI card can be obtained from any Motoclub in Italy or directly from the Motoclub Pepe BEVAGNA A.S.D. at the promotional cost of €45.

- Even the passengers must also hold an FMI Member card (without it, participation in the event is not permitted).

Art. 6 – Tracks and GPS

The routes to follow will be provided in GPX format (or other formats upon request) for use with GPS devices or smartphones. Each track will have a maximum size of 9,999 points, compatible with all GPS devices and smartphones. A list of towns along the routes, alternative variants, refueling points, and logistical information will also be provided.

Art. 7 – Registration check

Preliminary checks of motorcycles, distribution of the control sheet and identification wristband during the event, registration verification procedure, as well as documentation and gadgets delivery, will take place on Thursday, September 3rd from 2:30pm to 7:30pm and on Friday, September 4th, from 7:30am to 8:30am, in Bevagna (PG). The event will start on Friday, September 4th, at 9:00am. Participants who are not checked within the indicated times will be excluded from the event.

2–3 days before the start, participants will be provided with a GPX points summary to reach all important locations of the event, including start and finish points, restaurants, and main hotels.

Art. 7 bis – Start and Finish Areas

Temporary, non-mandatory, and unattended parking areas will be set up at the start and finish locations, sometimes marked with barriers or recommended by the official staff present on site. The rider is always responsible for their own vehicle. The organization is not responsible for theft or damage of any kind in these areas.

Art. 8 – Departures:

- **Friday, September 4:** 9:00am from Bevagna (after registration and luggage drop-off before 8:45am)
- **Saturday, September 5:** 5:30am from Passignano sul Trasimeno (with luggage drop-off before 5:15am)
- **Sunday, September 6:** 7:30am from Fabriano (with luggage drop-off before 7:15am)

Art. 9 – Safety Checks and Obligations

- **All participants will be provided with a control sheet and a wristband to be worn on the left wrist for checks. You are required to show it and have it verified by staff.**
- At refreshment points, lunch and dinner stops, or other necessary locations, checks will be carried out to verify participants' passage. It is mandatory to stop and have your passage recorded.
- Riders must travel in groups of at least 3 participants for safety reasons; those unable to form a group will be assigned to an existing group. The planned average speed is designed to ensure safety, enjoyment, and opportunities for photo stops. In case of bad weather, adjust your speed with extended travel times, following any "wet route" tracks provided.
- All riders must inform the emergency contact number immediately if they leave the route or withdraw from the Queen Trophy event.

Art. 10 –GPX Tracks delivery for GPS

The GPX track will be provided 2–3 days before the event via email to the address you provided, and you will be informed in advance through the WhatsApp group. Participants must arrive at the start with the tracks already uploaded on their GPS device.

Art. 11 – Medical and Mechanical Assistance

The event will be supported along the routes by:

- 2 doctors (in ambulance jeep and on motorcycles) for urgent medical assistance. The doctor will then organize appropriate specialized rescue through civil assistance services as needed.
- 6 pairs of bikers along the route, ready to assist participants as quickly as possible.



- 1 jeep with a trailer for recovering motorcycles in breakdowns, even in remote locations. These rescuers provide light, non-specialized assistance. In case of serious problems or complex mechanical issues, the motorcycle will be transported as quickly as possible to a junction or populated area (parking lot, square, gas station) where the participant can arrange recovery independently (see FMI agreement for free recovery of broken vehicles).
- The Event Management team will also follow the riders along the routes to be quickly available and ready to resolve problems as efficiently as possible.

Art. 12 – Luggage Service

The organization will handle luggage transportation. Each participant is entitled to transport **one (1) piece of luggage** with a maximum weight of **15 kg**. The luggage must be identified with the wristband/tag provided by the organization, showing the rider's number and name, and placed visibly on the luggage. The organization is **not responsible for the contents** of the luggage or for loss of the wristband/tag.

Art. 13 – Registration Fees and What it's included:

Registration by June 30th, 2026 with discounted fee:

- **A2 – Two days (Friday and Saturday / Saturday and Sunday):** Includes the GPS tracks for the two riding days, registration, medical assistance, light mechanical assistance, tracking system with OWAKA transponder and operator at the control station, gadgets, refreshments and Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast, refreshments, dinner, luggage transport, and insurance for personal and third-party damages.

Cost: Pilot €360 | Passenger +€160

- **A3 – Three days (Friday, Saturday, Sunday):** Includes the GPS tracks for the three riding days, registration, medical assistance, light mechanical assistance, tracking system with OWAKA transponder and operator at the control station, gadgets, refreshments, Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast, refreshments, dinner, Sunday refreshments and lunch, luggage transport.

Cost: Pilot €490 | Passenger +€220

Registration from 1/7/2026 to 20/08/2026:

- **B2 – Two days: Pilot €410 | Passenger +€200**

- **B3 – Three days: Pilot €550 | Passenger +€260**

A portion of this fee will be entirely donated to charity to support projects in Africa for the purchase of motorcycles to be used in Central Africa for transporting medicines, doctors, and people—providing the most suitable and fastest means for this type of service. Insurance coverage for personal damages is included.

Not included: mandatory FMI membership (also for passengers), accommodation, fuel, and vehicle recovery using means other than those provided by the organization.

Art. 13 bis – Payment Methods

Payment is required before submitting the registration form, attaching proof of payment. Follow the instructions on the website www.motoclubpepebevagna.it, starting from "Iscriviti" (Register).

Full payment via bank transfer:

1. Pre-fill the online form to know the exact amount to be paid
2. Make the bank transfer
3. Return to the registration and continue the sign-up process
4. When prompted, upload a copy of the transfer in the system
5. Once the operation is completed, you will receive an automatic confirmation
6. After verification by the Motoclub, you will receive the official confirmation of your registration

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Payment via PayPal (it is possible to make the payment in a single installment or in installments (currently over 6 or 12 months), with interest rates that will be communicated at the time of selection.)

The Motoclub Pepe Bevagna A.S.D. is not a tour operator; therefore, accommodation cannot be included in the registration fee. We do not use tour operators for bookings. Each participant is free to arrange their own accommodation as they see fit. Where possible, Motoclub Pepe Bevagna can suggest some already tried-and-tested hotels.

Art. 14 – Participants Limit

The maximum number of participants is 150. Any number exceeding this limit will be allowed solely at the discretion of the Organization.

Art. 15 – Withdrawals and Refunds

- Withdrawals, if properly justified and submitted by August 20, 2026, will receive a 50% refund of the registration fee.
- Alternatively, participants may transfer their registration to the following year's edition, receiving a 71,5% (about 350euros for the 3 days) credit of the fee already paid.

The withdrawal must be mandatorily communicated in writing, by e-mail or certified e-mail (PEC), no later than 20/08/2026, to the following addresses:

For withdrawals communicated after that date, no amount will be refunded. Any refunds will be processed within 30 days from the end of the event.

A participant who withdraws is entitled to transfer their registration to a third party by 20/08/2026, subject to prior notification to the organizing Motoclub. The Motoclub must authorize the operation by cancelling the withdrawing participant's registration and requesting the new participant to complete a new registration with their own details.

Art. 16 – Event Cancellation

In the event of cancellation due to force majeure not attributable to the organization, the registration fee will not be refunded.

Art. 16 bis – Government-Mandated Cancellation

If the event is cancelled due to government directives, the registration fee will be valid for the Queen Trophy 2027's edition.

Art. 17 – Immediate Exclusions

Failure to comply with the following rules will result in immediate exclusion from the event:

- Non-compliance with the Queen Trophy Regulations
- Non-compliance with the Road/Traffic Code
- Dangerous riding that may endanger other riders or third parties
- Non-compliant clothing or motorcycle as indicated in Art. 4
- Absence from the briefing, except in exceptional cases communicated in advance for serious reasons

Art. 18 – Event Deliberation Committee (CDE)

All cases not covered by this regulation and/or related to participation in the Queen Trophy Adventouring will be decided exclusively by the Event Deliberation Committee (CDE), whose decisions are final and binding regarding any complaints or disputes concerning the interpretation and application of this regulation.

The Organization reserves the right to communicate any modifications deemed necessary via dated and numbered circulars, media outlets, or online platforms. Such modifications will be considered an integral part of this regulation.



Art. 19 – Refusal of Registration

The Organization reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to refuse registration to participants deemed unsuitable or incompatible with participation to the Queen Trophy Adventouring.

Art. 20 – Image Rights

By registering, each participant implicitly authorizes the Motoclub Pepe Bevagna, organizer of the Queen Trophy Adventouring, to use their image. The Motoclub may use and distribute such images to produce videos/DVDs, reports, and journalistic articles. Professionals may be authorized to carry out video and photographic services for this purpose.

Art. 21 – Acceptance of Regulations

By registering, participants acknowledge having read and accepted this regulation, which governs the event in all its aspects, and agree to comply with it. Participants also release the Organizing Committee, the Sponsoring Entities, and all other parties without exception from any liability for damages or inconveniences that may arise to themselves, third parties, or third-party property due to the event and their participation, including traveling to the start in Bevagna (PG) or any other location along the route. By participating, participants waive any claims or recourse to authorities in advance. This regulation may be updated, and any changes will be communicated during preliminary operations.

By registering, participants confirm acceptance of the Regulation.
